The HQDA Tracking System provides a flexible, integrated, automated system for the control and management of actions, correspondence, filed documentation, executive requests, and internal actions to satisfy the needs of all activities within the HQDA. The system is flexible enough so that each agency can tailor it to its own specific needs, but it always contains a core of information concerning staff actions and document control for each agency. The goal of the system is to provide information concerning assigned tasks in a timely manner, reduce the amount of re-entry and duplication of information, promote information sharing among agencies, and eliminate tedious manual searching and telephonic inquiries to obtain action status.
